Making Sustainable Housing Affordable

Mike Siebert, Director of Affordable New Homes will be making sense of the new technologies and enlightening us on how we can build a sustainable home without spending a fortune.

Under the BRE's EcoHomes Assessment system, Affordable New Homes have managed to achieve an 'excellent' rating which is over 70%. All Housing Association projects currently have to, and often struggle to achieve 'very good', or 60% on this scale, and after April 5th this year it's going to get even tougher.

Thorough research into all aspects of micro generation, as well as new building methods and materials, have resulted in a range of house types, which not only reduce carbon emissions by well over the required 10%, but can also be built within the magic £60 000 threshold.

What is currently seen as a marketing advantage will soon be part of the Building Regulations, and we will all need to know about the ozone depletion potential of our insulation batts, not to mention our chains of custody, so you may as well start now, do your bit for the environment, and get ahead of the rest.
